Objetivo / Aim	COST brings together researchers and experts in different countries working on specific topics. COST does NOT fund research itself , but supports networking activities such as meetings, conferences, short-term scientific exchanges and outreach activities.

CARACTERÍSTICAS PRINCIPALES MAJOR CHARACTERISTICS	
Dotación / Financial support:	Actions are networks centred on nationally funded research projects in fields that are of interest to at least five COST countries. The financial support averages EUR 130 000 per year for a four-year period.
Requisitos / Eligibility:	Proposals submitted in one of the nine COST Domains follow a two-stage process whereby proposers, after <u>registering</u> , submit a Preliminary Proposal by a set collection date. This Preliminary Proposal provides an overview of the proposed <u>Action</u> 's goal and its foreseen impact. After evaluation, approximately 120 of the top-ranked Preliminary Proposals are invited to submit a <u>Full Proposal</u> . After assessment by external experts, the top-ranked Full Proposals are presented orally to the Domain Committee (<u>DC</u> Hearing). A final list is proposed for approval by the Committee of Senior Official (<u>CSO</u>).
