<b>CARACTERÍSTICAS PRINCIPALES ---- MAJOR CHARACTERISTICS</b>	
<b>Dotación/Financial support:</b>	Advanced Grants may be awarded up to a maximum of <b>EUR 2 500 000</b> for a period of <b>5 years</b> . The maximum award is reduced pro rata temporis for projects of a shorter duration. This does not apply to ongoing projects. However, up to an <b>additional EUR 1 000 000</b> can be requested.
<b>Requisitos /Eligibility:</b>	ERC Advanced Grant Principal Investigators are expected to be active researchers and to have a track record of significant research achievements <b>in the last 10 years</b> which must be presented in the application. There is little prospect of an application succeeding in the absence of such a record, which identifies investigators as exceptional leaders in terms of originality and significance of their research contributions.

<b>Documentación requerida / Application materials</b>	Proposals and pre-registrations are submitted electronically via the electronic submission system operated by the Commission services (currently available on the Research and Innovation Participant Portal) in accordance with the provisions of the ERC Work Programme. Proposals for 'frontier' research actions may – pursuant to the provisions of the ERC work programme - involve one or more Principal Investigator(s). Proposals are submitted by the PI (or by a contact person on behalf of the PI) empowered by the applicant legal entity (host institution), to which the grant may be awarded.
