Crue Spanish Universities and University of Sevilla, in collaboration with the Portuguese Rectors 'Conference (CRUP), are organising an information day on the Partnership for Research and Innovation Initiative in the Mediterranean Region "PRIMA", in Sevilla (Spain) on the 5th March 2018.

The PRIMA initiative currently consists of 19 participants. Including several countries from the Southern Mediterranean region (Algeria, Egypt, Jordan, Israel, Lebanon, Morocco, Tunisia and Turkey).

The partnership will be financed through a combination of funding from PRIMA Participating States (currently \in 274 million), and a \in 220 million contribution from the EU through Horizon 2020, its research and innovation funding programme. The main objective of PRIMA is to promote the excellence of research in the Mediterranean area, to encourage the emergence of new solutions to meet the challenges that are confronted by the Mediterranean communities with regard to water and food management and to encourage collaboration between researchers and innovators on both sides of the Mediterranean. The Strategic Agenda on Research and Innovation (SRIA) focuses on 3 main topics: water management, sustainable farming systems, and agro-food value chain; and 8 operational objectives: water-saving solutions, land and water sustainability, water gobernance system, smart and sustainable farming, pests and pathogens in farming, nutrition and health in the Mediterranean diet, reduction of losses and waste, and new agro-food business models.
