This action is open to researchers of any nationality who intend to conduct their research activity in any Member State or Associated Country.

CARACTERÍSTICAS PRINCIPALES MAJOR CHARACTERISTICS	
Dotación / Financial support:	Consolidator Grants may be awarded up to a maximum of EUR 2 000 000 for a period of 5 years. However, up to an additional EUR 750 000 can be requested in the proposal to cover (a) eligible "start-up" costs for Principal Investigators moving to the EU or an Associated Country from elsewhere as a consequence of receiving the ERC grant and/or (b) the purchase of major equipment and/or (c) access to large facilities
Requisitos / Eligibility:	The Principal Investigator shall have been awarded their first PhD over 7 and up to 12 years prior to the publication date of the call for proposals of the ERC Consolidator Grant. The effective elapsed time since the award of the first PhD can be reduced in certain properly documented circumstances.

Documentación requerida / Application materials	 Administrative Proposal Submission Forms (including the Ethics Review Table) are available online via the Participant Portal Submission System (PPSS) – pre-registration is required first.
