Requisitos / Eligibility:	Fellowships are either European Fellowships or Global Fellowships. European Fellowships are held in EU Member States or Associated Countries and are open to researchers currently within and outside Europe. The country where the European Fellowship is held is subject to the rules of mobility. Global Fellowships are based on a secondment to a third country and a mandatory 12 month return period to a European host. The country where the Global Fellowship secondment takes place is subject to the rules of mobility, whereas the return phase is not.

The action will also strengthen the contact network of both the researcher and the host organization. The fellowship will contribute to realizing the full potential of researchers and to catalyzing significant development in their careers in both the academic and non-academic sectors.
