Principal Investigators must demonstrate the ground-breaking nature, ambition and feasibility of their scientific proposal

CARACTERÍSTICAS PRINCIPALES MAJ	OR CHARACTERISTICS
Dotación/Financial support:	Starting Grants may be awarded up to a maximum of EUR 1 500 000 for a period of 5 years. The maximum size of the grants is reduced <i>pro rata temporis</i> for projects of a shorter duration. (This does not apply to ongoing projects). Additional funding up to EUR 1 000 000 can be requested in the proposal to cover the following eligible costs when these are necessary to carry out the proposed work: (a) "start-up" costs for Principal Investigators moving to the EU or an Associated Country from elsewhere as a consequence of receiving the ERC grant and/or (b) the purchase of major equipment and/or (c) access to large facilities and/or (d) other major experimental and field work costs, excluding personnel costs.
Requisitos /Eligibility:	The ERC's frontier research grants operate on a 'bottom-up' basis and applications can be made in any field of research with an emphasis on the frontiers of science, scholarship and engineering. In particular, the ERC encourages proposals of a multi- or interdisciplinary nature which cross the boundaries between different fields of research, pioneering proposals addressing new and emerging fields of research or proposals introducing unconventional, innovative approaches and scientific inventions. The requirements in terms of PhD award date are as follows: The first PhD shall have been awarded > 2 and ≤ 7 years prior to 1 January 2021

Documentación requerida / Application materials	Proposals are submitted electronically via the electronic submission system operated by the Commission services in accordance with the provisions of the Financial Regulation and the ERC Work Programme. Proposals for 'frontier' research actions may – pursuant to the provisions of the ERC Work Programme - involve one or a group of principal investigator(s). Proposals are submitted by a PI (or by a contact person on behalf of the PI) empowered by the applicant legal entity, to which the grant may be awarded. A proposal can be submitted in any official EU language. However, for reasons of efficiency, the use of English is strongly advised.
