CRIS believes that the training of researchers should go farther than the purely practical and scientific. For this reason, the awardees will be involved in a training plan that will provide them with mentoring and essential skills and insights to become future leaders of cancer research.</p>

<b>Duración</b>	The programme runs for three years in its first phase, international training phase (outgoing phase), and one more year during the return phase, at any Spanish institution.
<b>Dotación</b>	Up to 70.000 euros/year.
<b>Requisitos</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Applications will be accepted from cancer researchers who have completed a Doctorate in the last 5 years, or those that can demonstrate at between 4 and 9 years of full-time equivalent experience in cancer research prior to the year of the call for applications.</li> <li>➤ Fellows must not have resided or carried out their career in the country of the outgoing phase host institution for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately before the programme's year of recruitment.</li> </ul> <p><i>The CRIS Cancer Foundation will sign an agreement with the return host institution, which will sign a contract with the outgoing host institution.</i></p>
