CARACTERÍSTICAS PRINCIPALES MA	
Dotación/Financial support	Starting Grants may be awarded up to a maximum of <b>EUR 1 500 000</b> for a period of <b>5 years.</b> The maximum size of the grants is reduced <i>pro rata temporis</i> for projects of a shorter duration. (This does not apply to ongoing projects).Additional funding up to <b>EUR 1 000 000</b> can be requested in the proposal to cover the following eligible costs when these are necessary to carry out the proposed work: (a) "start-up" costs for Principal Investigators moving to the EU or an Associated Country from elsewhere as a consequence of receiving the ERC grant and/or (b) the purchase of major equipment and/or (c) access to large facilities and/or (d) other major experimental and field work costs, excluding personnel costs
Requisitos /Eligibility	The Principal Investigators shall have been awarded their first PhD <b>at least 2 and up to 7</b> <b>years prior to 1 January 2022</b> . Cut-off dates: PhD awarded from 1 January 2015 to 31 December 2019 (inclusive). The eligibility period can be extended beyond 7 years in certain properly documented circumstances. A competitive Starting Grant Principal Investigator must have already shown the potential for research independence and evidence of maturity, for example by having produced <b>at least one important publication</b> <b>as main author or without the participation of their PhD supervisor.</b> Applicant Principal Investigators should also be able to demonstrate a promising track record of early achievements appropriate to their research field and career stage, including significant publications (as main author) in major international peer-reviewed multidisciplinary scientific journals, or in the leading international peer-reviewed journals of their respective field. They may also demonstrate a record of invited presentations in well- established international conferences, granted patents, awards, prizes, etc
