Aim	The goal of MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships is to enhance the creative and innovative potential of researchers holding a PhD and who wish to acquire new skills through advanced training, international, interdisciplinary and inter-sectoral mobility. MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships will be open to excellent researchers of any nationality. The scheme also encourages researchers to work on research and innovation projects in the non-academic sector and is open to researchers wishing to reintegrate in Europe, to those who are displaced by conflict, as well as to researchers with high potential who are seeking to restart their careers in research

CARACTERÍSTICAS PRINCIPALES ---- MAJOR CHARACTERISTICS	
Financial support	Eligible costs must take the form of unit contributions, as stipulated in Decision of 11 March 2021 authorising the use of lump sum contributions and unit contributions for Marie Skłodowska-Curie actions under the Horizon Europe Programme
Eligibility	The researcher must be in possession of a doctoral degree or have successfully defended their doctoral thesis before call deadline. The researcher cannot have resided or carried out his/her main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the country of the beneficiary for more than 12 months in the 36 months immediately prior to the call deadline Maximum 8 years from date of award of the (first) doctoral degree. This limit can be extended (in days) for the following reasons: – Maternity leave (18 months – i.e. 548 days per child born after the PhD award date, or the exact duration of maternity leave taken, whichever is longest); – Paternity leave (exact duration per child born after the PhD award date); – Research in a non-associated TC (only for nationals or long-term residents of MS or AC, wishing to reintegrate in Europe); 11 – Compulsory national service; – Time spent not working in research; – Long-term sick leave (periods > 30 days)
PRESENTACIÓN DE SOLICITUDES ---- APPLICATION PROCEDURE	
Application materials	A proposal consists of an administrative part (Part A, filled in online via the submission forms) and a narrative part B composed of two separate PDF files (Part B1 and Part B2), which must be uploaded as separate PDF files: 1. Part B1, containing a maximum of 10 (ten) A4-sized pages. Any excess pages (i.e. numerical page 11 and beyond) will not be available to the evaluators; 2. Part B2, with no strict page limit for A4-sized pages.
